## UPDATE FROM WASHINGTON

- Nearly 300 bills passed including:
  - H.R.1 For the People Act, an important government corruption and election reform package
  - Bills to defend protections for people with preexisting conditions and reduce the cost of prescription drugs
  - Historic background check legislation, the first time in 20 years that the House passed major gun control legislation



# ENERGY, ENVIRONMENT, & AGRICULTURE UPDATE

### • Bills Passed

• The **Climate Action Now Act**, my amendment would require the President to use diplomacy to encourage other parties to the Paris Agreement to reach their individual goals

• John D. Dingell, Jr. Conservation, Management, and Recreation Act, signed into law March, 2019



## ENERGY, ENVIRONMENT, & AGRICULTURE UPDATE

### • Bills Cosponsored

- The **Climate Solutions Act**, requires 100% of electricity sold in the U.S. come from renewable sources by 2035
- The **Restore Our Public Parks and Lands Act**, reduces deferred maintenance backlog of our National Park Service and other federallymanaged outdoor spaces
- The National Heritage Area Act, ensures sustained funding for National Heritage Areas. There are eight in PA, including those around the Schuylkill and Susquehanna rivers.



## ENERGY, ENVIRONMENT, & AGRICULTURE UPDATE

#### • Other Work

- Hosted USDA Secretary Perdue in Kennett Square to talk about the impact of trade and workforce issues facing our agricultural industry
- Toured **dairy and mushroom farms** to learn more about their challenges and the important work they do for our community
- Working on a solution to a **workforce shortage** issue for year-round agricultural industry
- Worked with producers to address lags in EPA licenses during government shutdown
