 - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Protecting Mushroom
- 5 Farmers Act".

1	SEC. 2. RESEARCH AND DEVELOPMENT ON MUSHROOMS.
2	Section 522(c) of the Federal Crop Insurance Act (7
3	U.S.C. 1522(c)) is amended by adding at the end the fol-
4	lowing:
5	"(20) Mushrooms.—
6	"(A) IN GENERAL.—The Corporation shall
7	carry out research and development, or offer to
8	enter into 1 or more contracts with 1 or more
9	qualified persons to carry out research and de-
10	velopment, regarding a policy to insure—
11	"(i) the production of mushroom
12	growing media; and
13	"(ii) the production of mushrooms.
14	"(B) AVAILABILITY OF POLICY.—Notwith-
15	standing the second sentence of section
16	508(a)(1), and section $508(a)(2)$, the Corpora-
17	tion shall make a policy described in subpara-
18	graph (A) available if the requirements of sec-
19	tion 508(h) are met.
20	"(C) RESEARCH AND DEVELOPMENT DE-
21	SCRIBED.—Research and development described
22	in subparagraph (A) shall evaluate the effective-
23	ness of policies described in that subparagraph,
24	including policies that—
25	"(i) are based on the risk of—

1	"(I) pests, including mushroom
2	phorid flies and sciarid flies;
3	"(II) fungal pathogens; and
4	"(III) viral pathogens;
5	"(ii) consider other causes of loss ap-
6	plicable to mushroom compost and mush-
7	room production, such as—
8	"(I) a loss of electricity due to
9	weather; and
10	"(II) loss of growing media due
11	to excessive 5-year, 10-year, or 20-
12	year rainfall events;
13	"(iii) consider appropriate best prac-
14	tices to minimize the risk of loss;
15	"(iv) consider whether to provide cov-
16	erage for mushrooms under 1 policy or to
17	provide coverage for various phases of pro-
18	duction;
19	"(v) have streamlined reporting and
20	paperwork requirements that take into ac-
21	count short propagation schedules, variable
22	crop years, and the variety of mushrooms
23	that may be produced in a single facility;

"(D) REPORT.—Not later than 2 years after the date of enactment of this paragraph, the Corporation shall submit to the Committee on Agriculture of the House of Representatives and the Committee on Agriculture, Nutrition, and Forestry of the Senate a report that describes—

10"(i) the results of the research and11development carried out under subpara-12graph (A); and

13 "(ii) any recommendations with re-14 spect to those results.".
