CHIPS AND SCIENCE ACT

- The CHIPS Program Office estimates that building and operating domestic semiconductor facilities could require more than 100,000 construction workers to build the facilities and 90,000 workers to operate them.
- The CHIPS Act will build a domestic semiconductor workforce by:
 - Investing in Manufacturing Facilities
 - Partnering with Industry and Education and Training Providers
 - Supporting Semiconductor Education and Training
 - Fueling Research and Development

CHIPS ACT BENEFITS FOR COMMUNITY COLLEGES AND STUDENTS:

- **Funding and Workforce Development:**
 - Includes \$11 billion for semiconductor manufacturing workforce development, \$200 million for a CHIPS for America Workforce and Education Fund, and \$81 million for National Science Foundation's (NSF) critical infrastructure workforce training.
- **STEM Enhancement and Workforce Preparation:**
 - Updates the Advanced Technological Education (ATE) program under NSF to establish a network at community colleges. These updates will advance research for STEM education, provide students with hands-on training and research experiences.
- **Producing Quality Jobs:**
 - Ensures that community colleges are pivotal in fostering collaborations with businesses and assist graduates to find jobs that offer fair compensation, benefits, and supportive working conditions.
