RECENT ACCOMPLISHMENTS

- Secured \$1 million in Community Project Funding for the revitalization of Ash Park
- Assisted Coatesville with more than \$600,000 of FEMA funding for flood mitigation
- Worked with former President Trump to delay the closure of the Lockheed Martin/Sikorsky facility in Coatesville
- Supported Piasecki Aircraft Corporations proposal to fly ARES and ground test HPEM Hydrogen Fuel Cell in a programmatic expansion
- Invited Veterans Administration Secretary Denis McDonough to Chester County to visit the Coatesville VA
- Convened round table with area hospital leaders and Sec. McDonough to discuss healthcare impacts of AIR Commission report and forecasted CVAMC closure

- Cosponsored and voted for The Honoring Our PACT Act, the largest investment in healthcare for veterans in our country's history
- Made history as the first Member of Congress to ever win two awards in the same year by the non-partisan Congressional Management Foundation
 - Houlahan was recognized as "Best in Congress" for Constituent Services and Workplace Environment
- Passed legislation in the U.S. House to keep U.S. oil from our Strategic Petroleum Reserves from being sold to Chinese-affiliated companies and other sanctioned nations like Russia, North Korea, and Iran
- Appointed as the Economic Growth and Fiscal Responsibility Task Force Chair for the New Democrat Coalition
- Brought members of the Biden Administration to the district to highlight investments in infrastructure, innovation in semi-conductor chip manufacturing, and economic growth in our small business sector
- Thanks to the Inflation Reduction Act, lowered the cost of prescription drugs by limiting out-of-pocket expenses to \$2,000/year and capped the price of insulin at \$35/month for Medicare recipients
- Passed the first comprehensive gun violence prevention legislation in a generation (The Bipartisan Safer Communities Act)

DELIVERING CONSTITUENT SERVICES *(Since January 2019)*

- More than \$49,900,000 returned to constituents through casework services
- We have resolved 7,434 total cases on behalf of PA-06 constituents
- 322,760 emails sent and 30,758 phone calls returned
