- <u>Calling on Israel</u> to abide by our shared principles and allow as much humanitarian aid into Gaza as possible given the escalating humanitarian crisis.
- Writing a <u>letter</u> to President Biden urging the Administration to use our relationship with Israel to push for an immediate and significant shift in the Israeli military strategy toward Hamas to protect innocent Palestinian lives.
- Expressing my concerns about an extension of the conflict into Rafah and the devastating impact it could have on civilians.
- Calling for an investigation into Israel's <u>strike on World Central Kitchen</u> workers and accountability for this tragedy.
- Sending a <u>letter</u> with several of my colleagues to President Biden urging that he adhere to the Foreign Assistance Act, which prohibits the U.S. from providing arms sales to countries restricting the delivery of humanitarian aid, either directly or indirectly.
- Writing a <u>letter</u> to President Biden to express my concern about Israel's use of heavy bombs on a designated humanitarian zone in Gaza.
- Joining 145 Democrats in sending a <u>letter</u> to President Trump calling on him to retract his dangerous plan for the U.S. to take control of Gaza. This proposal would not guarantee Israel's security but would, in fact, do the opposite and serve as a recruitment tool for terrorist organizations, putting Americans, Israelis, and Palestinians at risk and fueling anti-American and anti-Israeli sentiments in the Middle East.
