RECENT ACCOMPLISHMENTS

- Through the National Defense Authorization Act (NDAA), successfully passed 36 proposals including provisions for paid family leave, support for maternal health, and efforts to disrupt fentanyl trafficking
- Led 25 Members of Congress in calling for full funding for AmeriCorps, fighting back against proposed cuts
- Cosponsoring the Building Civic Bridges Act, to fund new civic bridge building efforts to bring Americans together
- Cosponsor of the bipartisan National Apprenticeship Act of 2023, a comprehensive bill that would modernize and expand apprenticeship programs across the country
- Introduced the Public Service Loan Forgiveness Payment Completion Fairness Act, a bipartisan bill that helps teachers, frontline workers, and other public service employees access student loan relief by removing a burdensome provision in federal law.

- Nominated 32 students from PA-06 to our country's military academies in 2023 and a total of 122 students over the past five years
- Delivered on promise of bipartisanship by introducing 92% of bills in the 118th Congress with bipartisan support and received the Legislative Action Award from the Bipartisan Policy Center

DELIVERING CONSTITUENT SERVICES (Since January 2019)

- **\$56,676,774** returned to constituents through casework services.
- **8,581** cases resolved for our community.
- **367,912** emails sent and **38,128** phone calls returned
