I am requesting funding for Southern Chester County Regional Police Department's Body Worn Camera and Taser Project in fiscal year 2024. The entity to receive funding for this project is the Southern Chester County Regional Police Department, located at 8934 Gap Newport Pike, Landenberg, PA 19350. The funding would be used for updated equipment to include new body-worn cameras (BWCs) and Taser 7 Conducted Energy Weapon (CEW). The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because lesslethal tools, like Taser CEWs, can be used to preserve human life. Body worn cameras provide an actual account of a police officer's interactions with the public and suspects and offer a wide range of benefits. These include, but are not limited to, protection against frivolous lawsuits, transparency and accountability in police activity, and opportunities to view footage for training purposes.
