




WHO DO I REPRESENT?

PROTECTING NATIONAL SECURITY

The National Defense Authorization Act was signed into law in December. It contains dozens of my initiatives including:

- Creation of a Cyber Academy scholarship program
- Improved supply chains for life-saving medications for servicemembers
- Increased support for Ukrainian fighter pilot training
- Improved childhood literacy services for families of servicemembers
- Continued support for paid family leave
