


#### WHO DO I REPRESENT?

Right now, the Pennsylvanian Sixth district includes all of **Chester County** and the southeastern part of **Berks County**, including the City of Reading. That's over 700,000 people!

However, the PA Supreme Court just approved updated congressional maps as a result of the 2020 census, which adds an additional area in Berks County. This will go into effect next year.



#### HEALTH CARE

- Passed the Affordable Insulin Now Act to cap out of pocket insulin costs at \$35 per month; in the Senate now
- Cosponsored the bipartisan Telehealth Modernization Act, which removes Medicare's restriction requiring patients to live in a rural area and use telehealth at a doctor's office or clinic.

- There is more work to be done. This Congress I have:
  - Hosted a town hall on gun violence prevention
  - Cosponsored and voted for the Bipartisan Background Checks
    Act and the Enhanced Background Checks Act
  - Cosponsored Ethan's Law which increases firearm storage requirements in homes with children
  - And more than 10 other pieces of legislation to keep us safe



#### MAINTAINING NATIONAL SECURITY

The annual National Defense Authorization Act (NDAA) passed bipartisanly out of committee last week. It includes:

- 19 of my amendments
- Measures to reduce our reliance on China for rare earth elements
- Measures to support military families
- Reauthorization of SBIR/STTR programs
