- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Supporting Technical
- 5 Experts in Managing Diplomacy Act" or the "STEM Di-
- 6 plomacy Act".

1 SEC. 2. WAIVER AUTHORITY FOR OCCUPATIONAL REQUIRE-

- The Secretary of State may waive any or all of the individual occupational requirements with respect to an employee or prospective employee of the Department of
- 6 State for a civilian position categorized under the GS-
- 7 0130 occupational series if the Secretary determines that
- 8 the individual possesses significant scientific, techno-
- 9 logical, engineering, or mathematical expertise that is inte-
- 10 gral to performing the duties of the applicable position,
- 11 based on demonstrated job performance and qualifying ex-
- 12 perience. With respect to each waiver granted under this
- 13 section, the Secretary shall set forth in a written document
- 14 that is transmitted to the Director of the Office of Per-
